

# GRANT SELECTION CRITERIA



#### Please read this section carefully before completing your application.

When returning your application, please also provide copies of the documents listed below that are current and **relevant** to your circumstances:

- I. Evidence of your acceptance onto your course of study for the academic year
- 2. A priced equipment list for books/ materials that are required for the course
- 3. A copy of your halls/ tenancy agreement
- 4. Results of any applications for funding from the Local Authority or other source towards the cost of the course including Bursary, Access/ Hardship Fund
- 5. Evidence of your/ your parents' income, including benefits
- 6. Recent proof of course fees/ balance for the academic year, if applicable
- 7. Letter from your childminder of days of attendance, time & cost etc, if applicable
- 8. Copy of all your bills/ expenditures
- 9. A copy of your/ your parents' mortgage/ tenancy agreement
- 10. Photo I.D
- 11. Your Bank details (if you are awarded a grant, we will need this to make a payment)

Please ensure that you complete **ALL SECTIONS** of the form. The Trustees will be looking for information about your/ your parents' income, expenditure and any personal circumstances relevant to your application. An educational grant relates only to the additional expense incurred by your chosen course, however the Trustees will take into consideration your ongoing unrelated expenses too.

I would like to advise you at this stage that our Charity may not be in a position to fund you to the extent that you require. The amount awarded to you will only be known after consideration of your case, on interview by our Committee.

The Charity expects students to take up the loan offered by Student Finance England. Applications will not be considered, unless there are special circumstances, if the Student Finance loan has not been taken up.

We would not withdraw an education grant if it were not spent within six months. Education grants are payable in termly instalments throughout an academic year. Someone could be awarded a grant in August and the final payment could be made anytime between April and July.

Applicants are invited to attend for an interview with our Education Committee and we will be writing to you to let you know the date of the next meeting once we receive your completed application form and supporting documents.

Please feel free to add any additional information about your interests and ambitions to your application. The more information you provide the easier it will be for us to prepare your profile to present to the Trustees.
